PETITION

1. The Petition of **Alhaji Atiku Abubakar**, GCON of Vice President's Residence, Aso Villa, Abuja; **Senator Ben Obi** of National Assembly Quarters, Apo Village, Abuja, and **Action Congress (AC)** of 16 Bissau Street, Wuse Zone 6, Abuja, whose names are subscribed.
2. Your 1st and 2nd Petitioners are members of the 3rd Petitioner, and were validly nominated as Presidential and Vice Presidential Candidates respectively at the Presidential Election held on the 21st of April, 2007.
3. Your 3rd Petitioner is a registered Political Party in Nigeria. The 3rd Petitioner sponsored the 1st and 2nd Petitioners as candidates in the aforementioned Election.
 - 3a. The 1st Respondent was a candidate sponsored by the 3rd Respondent at the Presidential Election held on 21st April, 2007 in which election the 2nd Respondent was his running mate.
4. The 4th Respondent is the State body charged with the responsibility of conducting, supervising, undertaking and organizing elections into elective offices created by the Constitution.

5. The 5th Respondent is the Chairman of the 4th Respondent and at all times material to this Petition, the Chief Executive Officer of the Commission with a decisive role in all matters affecting the Presidential Election.
6. The 5th Respondent was the Chief Electoral Commissioner and Returning Officer at the Presidential Election. In addition to the 5th Respondent, the 7th - 808th Respondents and numerous other officers including ad-hoc staff acted as agents of the 4th Respondent in the conduct of the April 21, 2007 election.
7. Your Petitioners state that the Presidential Election was held on 21st April, 2007 in which twenty-five (25) political parties fielded candidates: Alhaji Atiku Abubakar was validly nominated on the platform of Action Congress (AC) although excluded by 4th Respondent, Alhaji Umaru Musa Yar'Adua contested on the platform of PDP, Major General Muhammadu Buhari (Rtd) contested on the platform of ANPP, Chief Orji Uzor Kalu on the platform of PPA, Attahiru Dalhatu Bafarawa on the platform of DPP, Dim Chukwuemeka Odumegwu-Ojukwu contested on the platform of APGA, Chief Christopher Pere Ajuwa contested on the platform of AD, Professor Patrick O. Utomi contested on the platform of ADC, Dr. Brimmy Asekharuagbom Olaghere contested on the platform of NPC, Chief Ambrose Owuru contested on the platform of HDP, Arthur Nwankwo contested on the platform of PMP, Reverend Chris Okotie contested on the platform of FRESH, Chief Emmanuel Osita Okereke contested on the platform of ALP, Sir Lawrence F. Adedoyin contested on the platform of APS, Alhaji Aliyu Habu Habu Fari contested on the platform of NPD, Galtima Baboyi Liman contested on the platform of NNPP, Maxi Okwu contested on the platform of CPP, Chief Sunny Joseph Okogwu contested on the platform of RPN, Dr. Iheanyichukwu G. Nnaji contested on the platform of BNPP, Dr. Osagie O. Obayuwana contested on the platform of NCP, Dr. Olapade Agoro contested on the platform of NAC, Dr. Akpone Solomon contested on the platform of NMDP, Professor Isa Odidi contested on the platform of ND, Mallam Aminu G. Abubakar contested on the platform of NUP, and Major Rev. Dr. Moji Obasanjo contested on the platform of MMN.

8. Your Petitioners state that following the said Presidential Election referred to in paragraph 7 above, the following scores were allocated to the candidates as announced by the 5th Respondent and also posted on INEC website (www.inecnigeria.org/election) on the 23rd of April, 2007 - (Including the score allocated to the 1st Petitioner):

9. Your Petitioners aver that at a press conference held on the 23rd of April, 2007 the 6th Respondent announced the scores for only three (3) candidates shown below which differed from the scores as stated in paragraph 8 (A) and (B) above:

At the trial, your Petitioners will found on the video tape of the press conference as well as the print outs from the 4th Respondent's website showing the discrepancies as highlighted above.

All efforts by the Petitioners to obtain the hard copies of the said result proved abortive up till the time of filing this Petition.

10. Your Petitioners state that at the end of the Presidential Election referred to in paragraphs 8 and 9 above, Alhaji Umaru Musa Yar'Adua of the People's Democratic Party (PDP) was returned elected as announced by the 6th Respondent on the 23rd of April, 2007 with a total score of 24,638,063; and on the website of INEC with a total score of 24,784,227.
11. Your Petitioners shall contend that the scores ascribed to each of the candidates as shown above were not a true reflection of the candidates' actual scores but rather the product of deliberate wrong entries and allocation of figures made by the 4th Respondent's agents or officers at the Polling Units, Wards, Local Government Areas and State Collation Centres.

The declared results of the Presidential Election held on 21st of April, 2007 is hereby pleaded.

12. In the performance of its statutory functions in the conduct of elections including the Presidential Election, the 4th Respondent, its agents and officers are constitutionally and statutorily enjoined to be independent, neutral, fair, impartial, and at all times to act in the interest of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
13. Your Petitioners aver that under Section 29 (1) of the Electoral Act, 2006, the 5th Respondent and all other officers and agents of the 4th Respondent are mandatorily required to affirm or swear to an Oath of allegiance to the Federal Republic of Nigeria and neutrality in the conduct of the election as provided for in the Second Schedule of the Electoral Act.
14. Your Petitioners state that the Presidential Election held on 21st of April, 2007 was vitiated by acts of unlawful exclusion, widespread corrupt practices, bias and partiality; your Petitioners also state that the result of the Election was substantially affected by non-compliance with the provisions of the Electoral Act, 2006.
15. The grounds on which this Petition is based are:

- (a). the 1st Petitioner was validly nominated by the 3rd Petitioner but was unlawfully excluded from the election;

ALTERNATIVELY THAT:-

- (b) the election was invalid by reason of corrupt practices;
- (c) the election was invalid for reason of non-compliance with the provisions of the Electoral Act, 2006 as amended; and
- (d) the 1st Respondent was not duly elected by the majority of lawful votes cast at the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election.

16. FACTS OF UNLAWFUL EXCLUSION

The facts on which the ground of unlawful exclusion is based are:

- (a) The 1st Petitioner was duly nominated by the 3rd Petitioner as its candidate for the 21st April, 2007 Presidential Election;
- (b) Upon the nomination of the 1st Petitioner, the nomination form was duly completed and submitted to the 4th Respondent;
- (c) After submission, the 4th Respondent on 28th day of December, 2006 invited all the candidates including the 1st Petitioner to its screening and verification exercise;
- (d) Subsequent to the screening and verification exercise, the 4th Respondent published a statement of the full list of the names of candidates standing nominated pursuant to the Electoral Act;
- (e) In the statement of the full names of candidates standing nominated published by the 4th Respondent, the name of the 1st Petitioner was unlawfully excluded;
- (f) In addition to sub paragraphs (a) - (e) above, the 4th and 5th Respondents, at different public fora and after nomination

had closed, repeatedly declared and stated that the 1st Petitioner was disqualified from contesting the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election and implacably maintained this position until the day of the election.

- (g) The Petitioners will contend further that the 4th and 5th Respondents were biased and deliberately failed to give the Petitioners equal opportunity as was given to other candidates to participate in the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election.
- (h) The Petitioners will contend that the action of the 4th and 5th Respondents as enumerated in paragraphs (a) - (f) above, was deliberate and effectively excluded the 1st and 2nd Petitioners from engaging in a meaningful and effective contest as a candidate at the election for which he had been validly nominated by the 3rd Petitioner.

Particulars of Unlawful Exclusion

- i. The 3rd Respondent by a letter dated 18th January, 2007 actually instigated the events that led to the unlawful exclusion of the 1st Petitioner.
- ii. Upon becoming aware of the letter by the 3rd Respondent during the screening, the 1st Petitioner, in his capacity as a nominated candidate, replied, through his Counsel, to the 4th Respondent, informing the 4th Respondent that the allegations made by the 3rd Respondent were unfounded.
- iii. The 4th Respondent at no time thereafter reverted to the Petitioners about their response.
- iv. On the 7th day of March, 2007, the Federal High Court in *Suit No.: FHC/ABJ/CS/03/2007* between *Action Congress vs. INEC & Anor.*, Judgment was delivered by Kuewumi J. in which it was adjudged, amongst others, that the 4th Respondent lacked power to disqualify a candidate at an election and that such power lies with the Court of Law.

The said Judgment shall be relied upon.

- v. Thereafter, in defiance of the said Judgment, the 4th Respondent proceeded to publish its official list of candidates excluding the name of the 1st Petitioner. In addition, the said list was posted on INEC website.
- vi. A letter was written by the 3rd Petitioner to the 4th and 5th Respondents on the 9th day of February, 2007 complaining about the unlawful exclusion of its candidate.
- vii. The 4th Respondent replied the Petitioner's letter on 17th February, 2007 declining to revisit the unlawful exclusion.

The letters are hereby pleaded.

- viii. Following the insistence of 4th Respondent on the 1st Petitioner's unlawful exclusion, an action was instituted at the Federal High Court, Abuja in *Suit No.: FHC/ABJ/CS/152/2007 (Alhaji Atiku Abubakar & Anor vs. INEC & Anor.)* before Tijani Abubakar J., Judgment was delivered on the 3rd day of April, 2007 whereupon it was declared as follows:

“(1) That an order is made directing the Defendants not to exclude the 1st Plaintiff from contesting the election to the office of the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.

(2) That if excluded it is hereby ordered that Defendants include the Name of the 1st Plaintiff as the Presidential Flag bearer of the 2nd Plaintiff.

(3) That the Defendants are hereby restrained from excluding the name of the 1st Plaintiff as the Presidential candidate of the 2nd Plaintiff except upon pronouncement by a Court of Law.”

The Judgment which is still subsisting shall be relied upon at the trial.

- ix. Your Petitioners shall lead evidence that in defiance of the Order/Judgment of the Court, the 4th and 5th Respondents persisted in their decision to unlawfully exclude the Petitioners, and stated that it would only obey Orders made by the Supreme Court.
- x. Your Petitioners shall lead evidence that apart from the final list of presidential candidates published by the 4th Respondent on 15th March, 2007, no further amended, supplementary or modified list of Presidential candidates was published by the 4th Respondent in which the name of the Petitioners were included.
- xi. Notwithstanding the fact that the 1st Petitioner was unlawfully excluded, the 4th Respondent proceeded to allocate 2,637,848 votes to the 1st Petitioner as a candidate in the election.
- xii. By reason of the unlawful exclusion, it became practically impossible for the 1st Petitioner to present himself effectively as a candidate at the election and for his supporters to canvass for votes on his behalf.
- xiii. The 1st Petitioner was, prior to the election, a two-term Vice President, who had won two (2) previous Presidential Elections on a joint ticket with the incumbent President, General Olusegun Obasanjo.
- xiv. Upon joining the 3rd Petitioner, the 1st Petitioner pulled a substantial followership which stood him in good stead to have won the election but for the 4th Respondent's acts of unlawful exclusion.
- xv. In the course of seeking reversal of his unlawful exclusion, a Judgment of the Supreme Court was delivered on Monday, 16th April, 2007 where it was adjudged that the 4th Respondent had no power to disqualify a candidate in an election without a lawful Court Order.

- xvi. Notwithstanding the Judgment of the Federal High Court of 3rd April, 2007 and the Judgment of the Supreme Court of 16th April, 2007, the 4th Respondent still refused to restore and/or publish the name of the 1st Petitioner on the list of candidates standing nominated as at Tuesday, 17th April, 2007.
- xvii. On Tuesday 17th April, 2007, the 809th Respondent in contravention of the Electoral Act, 2006, and the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 issued an Order prohibiting campaign and public meetings until after the date of the Presidential Election, which Order was brazenly enforced by the law enforcement agencies.
- xviii. By the prohibition order issued by the 809th Respondent, the Petitioners were effectively deprived of the opportunity to undertake their electioneering campaign up to the 20th of April, 2007, when by law campaigns were to cease.
- xix. That the party symbol of the 3rd Petitioner as approved by the 4th Respondent was not reflected on the ballot paper used for the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election the object and effect of which was to exclude the Petitioners from a meaningful and effective participation in the election.

At the trial, your Petitioners shall rely on Newspaper publications, video recordings, mobile phone visual recordings, photographs, correspondences, and other forms of communications and other relevant documents exchanged between the parties.

17. FACTS OF NON COMPLIANCE

The facts on which the ground of non compliance is based are:

- (a) Your Petitioners hereby repeat all the facts pleaded in paragraph 16 above and adopt same as facts in support of the ground of Non Compliance with the Electoral Act and the INEC Guidelines by the 4th - 808th Respondents and officers who

acted for the 4th Respondent in the conduct of the presidential election of 21st April, 2007.

- (b) Your Petitioners further state that in the conduct of the Presidential Election, there was non-compliance in that:
- i. Up to and including the date of election, 21st of April, 2007, there was no final voters' list as prescribed by the Electoral Act, 2006 as amended. The result was that a multitude of eligible voters were disenfranchised throughout the federation.
 - ii. Election was not held at the same time and day throughout the federation. The time fixed by the 4th Respondent for election was 8.00am - 3.00pm.
 - iii. On the 19th of April, 2007, the 4th Respondent arbitrarily changed the time of the poll of April 21, 2007 to commence at 10.00am and close at 5.00pm.
 - iv. In the few places where election took place at all, the actual voting exercise in majority, if not in all the Local Government Areas, in practically all the states of the federation except Abuja and Lagos, did not open earlier than 2.00pm and continued till the early hours of the next day. The electoral officers namely 7th - 808th Respondents acting under strict instruction of their Resident Electoral Commissioners saw to it that the acts and gross neglect particularized in the preceding and succeeding subparagraphs herein were deliberately created.
 - v. Eligible voters who turned up at the appointed hour of the voting at 8.00am, were disenfranchised as they went back home believing that the elections would not hold.
 - vi. In respect of late polls which ran into the late hours of the night, fear and insecurity discouraged eligible voters from casting their votes in the few places where election took place at all.

- vii. The ballot papers used for the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election were without serial numbers, without counterfoils and were not in booklet form as prescribed by the Electoral Act, 2006 and INEC Election Manual.
- viii. In consequence, it became impossible to trace or audit ballot papers issued (used and unused) by the 4th Respondent for the purpose of the election throughout the federation.
- ix. The approved party symbol of the 3rd Petitioner which was well known to its teaming supporters was not reflected on the ballot papers with the result that a lot of eligible voters could not vote for the Petitioners.
- x. By contrast, the party symbol of the 3rd Respondent was properly and correctly reflected on the ballot paper thereby giving the 1st Respondent an undue advantage at the election.
- xi. The 4th Respondent did not publish the full list of validly nominated candidates in the April 21, 2007 Presidential election as required by the Electoral Act, 2006.
- xii. In the few places where voting took place at all, there was multiple voting, scores of candidates were not entered by the Presiding Officers at the polling units in Form EC8As; the forms were not signed by the Presiding Officers at the polling units nor countersigned by party agents except for those of the 3rd Respondent. Results were not announced at the designated Polling Units and at the various designated wards, collation centers, in most Local Government Areas in all the states of the federation except Lagos and Abuja.
- xiii. Forms EC8As and EC8Bs were produced in two parallel copies in duplicates bearing the same serial numbers to generate parallel results one of which invariably is authenticated and relied upon simply because majority votes were allocated to the 3rd Respondent therein. Typical examples of these duplicitous result forms are

those from Benue South Senatorial District in Benue State, and numerous other states.

- xiv. Counting of votes was not done at the polling units where elections were held and no results were declared at the Polling Units as prescribed by law. Instead, the 6th Respondent purported to have relied on results collated at state levels based on *“scores TRANSMITTED ELECTRONICALLY from the polling units and/or local governments across the nation.”*

Notice is hereby given to the 4th - 42nd Respondents to produce before this Honourable Court all the used and unused ballot papers, Forms EC8A, EC8B, EC8C, EC8D, EC8D(A), EC8E, EC25 and EC40C used during the 21st April, 2007 Presidential Election.

- xv. Your Petitioners aver that the electoral materials were not made available to most of the states of the federation, local government, wards and polling units, by the 4th Respondent, its agents and officers, on the 21st of April, 2007 for the Presidential Election, thereby denying majority of the electorate the right to vote for candidates of their choice in general and the 1st Petitioner in particular.
- xvi. Your Petitioners aver that there are about 120,000 polling units scattered along the length and breath of the federation of Nigeria with some of them located in riverine and mountainous areas.

Notice is hereby given to the 4th Respondent to produce the list of all the polling units in Nigeria, ward by ward, local government by local government, at the trial of this Petition.

- xvii. Your Petitioners further aver that some of the electoral materials actually arrived Nigeria in the evening of Friday, 20th April, 2007 from the Republic of South Africa thereby making it logistically impossible to distribute to the various polling units, wards, local governments and the

states of the federation before the date fixed for the election.

Reliance will be placed on South African Newspaper, *Mail&Guardian* of April 26 to May 3 2007.

xviii. Your Petitioners aver that some other of the electoral materials were flown into Nigeria on the day of the election by private chartered flight.

Reliance is hereby placed on Air Traffic Flight Schedule (Data) at the Murtala Mohammed Airport of 20th and 21st April, 2007.

xix. Your Petitioners will contend at the trial of this Petition that with the terrain and remoteness of many local government areas and states of the federation, coupled with the fact that there was need to sort out the materials for distribution, such election materials could not have been distributed and were not so distributed by the time fixed for the election.

xx. Your Petitioners aver that there was no open secret voting during the 21st April, 2007 Presidential Election in most parts of the federation as there was no polling booths erected for the election.

xxi. In the few places where elections took place, people whose names were not on the voters' register voted.

xxii. In the few places where election took place, many persons who had not attained the age of 18 years, voted.

xxiii. In many states, people voted in private houses, unauthorized, and undesignated places.

xxiv. The requisite forms meant for use in the distribution and authentication of electoral materials was not used by the 4th Respondent and its officers in the conduct of the election.

- xxv. Before and during the election, the 5th Respondent exhibited acts of gross bias with impunity against the person and candidature of the 1st Petitioner including:
- a. publicly calling the 1st Petitioner a ‘frustrated politician’;
 - b. falsely describing the 3rd Petitioner as an illegal organization not having being registered by INEC;
 - c. after the Judgment in Suit No.: FHC/ABJ/CS/03/07 pleaded in 16 (iv) above, the 5th Respondent boasted that he will not comply with the Judgment unless compelled by the Supreme Court;
 - d. in the course of processing the 1st Petitioner’s nomination, the 5th Respondent falsely denied receipt of the 1st Petitioner’s photograph required to be placed on the ballot paper when in actual fact same had been duly delivered.

xxvi. Your Petitioners aver that while election results from 25 states of the federation were still being awaited on 23rd day of April, 2007, the 5th Respondent excused himself and went out of the collation center at the Headquarters of the 4th Respondent leaving behind the party agents, to announce the result of the Presidential Elections, declaring the 1st Respondent the winner and making pronouncements of victory for the 1st - 3rd Respondents as the Returning Officer allegedly on the basis of scores **‘TRANSMITTED ELECTRONICALLY’** from various polling units and wards throughout the country.

As at the time of declaration of the result, state by state breakdown of the votes, or the percentage basis upon which the 1st Respondent was declared winner were not disclosed and till date have not been so disclosed.

xxvii. No Form EC8D(A) was completed before the result of the election was announced; whereas the Return Form EC8E was required by law to be produced from

FORM EC8D(A) which itself must have been produced from FORM EC8D to be brought by the respective state resident electoral commissioners, who must have collated the scores submitted to him from FORMS EC8Cs he must have collated from Electoral Officers of each of the Local Government Areas in the state, while the forms EC8Cs were to contain the collated results submitted by Ward Supervisory Presiding officers on the basis of Polling units result Form EC8As prepared by the presiding officers.

xxviii. The election was fundamentally flawed and did not meet the minimum standard of democratic election anywhere in the world as attested to in the several post-election reports, issued by numerous and reputable local and international observers as well as print and electronic media houses officially invited by the 4th Respondent to monitor the election.

Notice is hereby given to 4th Respondent, its agents and officers to produce Forms EC.25 and EC.40C used to record the distribution of election materials from the National Headquarters down to the various polling units in all the Local Governments in each of the 36 States of the Federation.

Notice is also given to the 4th Respondent, its agents and officers, to produce before this Honourable Court the Voters' Register for the presidential election, local government by local government, ballot papers (used and unused), list of the party agents earlier given to 4th Respondent by the political parties together with their specimen signatures.

The 4th Respondent, its agents and officers are hereby put on notice to produce the results Forms EC8A, EC8B, EC8C, EC8D, EC8D(A) and EC8E in each of the polling units, wards, Local Governments, in all the 36 states of the federation including the Federal Capital Territory,

Abuja for both the Presidential and the National Assembly elections.

Evidence shall be led to establish the aforementioned allegations through CD and video clips, mobile phone visual recordings, photographs, international and local observers' report, newspapers and magazines including *The News Magazine, Tell, The Guardian, ThisDay, Nigerian Tribune and The Nation.*

18. CORRUPT PRACTICES

The facts on which the ground of corrupt practices is based are:

- (a) Your Petitioners aver that the election was invalid by reason of widespread corrupt practices comprising ballot stuffing, multiple voting, ballot boxes snatching, intimidation, over-voting, inflation of results, bribery, under supply of voting materials, threats, falsification, beatings, killings, by the 1st - 4th Respondents, their agents and officers. These corrupt practices occurred in virtually all the States of the Federation, Local Government Areas, wards, and polling stations, but featured more especially in the following states:

ANAMBRA STATE

- i. In Anambra State election materials arrived late from Enugu which affected onward distribution to the 21 Local Government Areas. In Awka North, Awka South, Onitsha North, Nnewi North Local Government Areas, hijacked ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes even when there was no actual voting, ballot boxes were snatched, to the extent that the 2nd Petitioner, Chief Edwin Ume Ezeoke, vice presidential candidate of All Nigeria Peoples Party (ANPP) and the incumbent Governor of Anambra State, could not vote whereas results were declared by the 4th Respondent. Further:
 - i. In Nnewi South, Onitsha South, Onitsha North, Nnewi North, Ekwusigo, Njikoka, Anaocha Local Government Areas, there was absolutely no election.

Election materials for the presidential and national assembly elections were later found abandoned in the bush at Nnewi North and Onitsha South Local Government Areas.

- ii. In Idemili North Local Government Area, there was no exercise in all the wards except Obosi ward mainly because election materials arrived late in the evening, and they were subsequently returned to the INEC office at Ogidi.
- iii. In Idemili South Local Government Area, actual voting took place only in Awka-Etiti Ward I for just one hour. The other eleven (11) wards, election materials arrived between 6.00pm and 8.00pm and they had to be returned to the INEC office at Ojoto.
- iv. In Awka South Local Government Area, voting took place for only an hour in Nibo I & II, Nise II, and Amawbia II & III, all the other remaining 15 Wards did not hold any election due to late arrival of materials or absence of INEC officials.
- v. In Awka North Local Government Area, material was distributed only to Mgbakwu Ward, Achalla I, II, and III.
- vi. In Orumba North Local Government Area, the materials left the Local Government Secretariat at about 6.30pm; none of the materials was seen in any ward or polling station.
- vii. In Ogbaru Local Government Area, there was no election in the whole of Okpoko Area comprising of 6 wards. In the rest of the wards, the election materials were returned to INEC office because of darkness.
- viii. In Dunukofia Local Government Area, election was held for about an hour, the electoral officer despite my personal intervention refused to avail any party

agent with the result as collated at the wards, claiming that he had only three (3) copies of the result sheet.

- ix. In Ihiala Local Government Area, the materials were dispatched from the local government Secretariat at about 6.30pm; none of the election materials was sighted in any ward, much less an election taking place.
- x. In Aguata Local Government Area, the exercise was marred by unbelievable height of irregularities, intimidation and non-compliance with known electoral rules and regulations. Labour Party for instance, won with 90% votes for House of Representative election while PDP purportedly 'swept' with landslide victory in the presidential and senate elections.

ADAMAWA STATE

- ii. In Adamawa State particularly in Yola the Governor was placed under house arrest and prevented from casting his vote; majority of eligible voters in Adamawa North Senatorial District were prevented from voting, ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot boxes were snatched, election materials meant for voting were abandoned in the bush, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences. Card carrying members of 3rd Respondent were recruited as ad-hoc staff of 4th respondent to conduct the election. Election materials were not delivered in the few local government areas and or wards before 1pm, where it was delivered at all. This deprived majority of eligible voters who turned out early, of the opportunity to vote, as they had to leave on sighting no electoral officers and material. This pattern of malpractice was replicated in nearly all the local government areas of the State as typified by Numan, Shelleng, Fufore, Mubi, Lamurde and Madegali Local Government Areas. In Nasarawa Yola North Local Governemnt Area where voting materials arrived at

about 1pm the voting was stopped at 4pm, as against the 5pm officially permitted.

Protest letters to the State Resident Electoral Commissioner from the 3rd Petitioner's officials in Adamawa State shall be founded upon including letters dated 22/4/07 and 23/4/07.

BAUCHI STATE

- iii. In Bauchi State, especially in Bauchi North Senatorial District, the Presidential Election did not hold on Saturday, the 21st of April, 2007 but on Sunday, 22nd April, 2007. Ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot boxes snatched, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences.

BAYELSA STATE

- iv. Election materials arrived very late in all the local government headqutres. In some cases they never arrived at all owing to the riverine and difficult terrain of the state. In all the lopcak governemtn areas of bayesla state without exception, election material released to 4th respondent officials did not include Result forms EC8As, EC8bs, and EC8Cs. As a result, some supervisory presiding officers, afraid for their lives, simply disappeared from the local government INEC offices where they incomplete lection material were delivered to them. They never showed up at the ward level to distribute the election materials to the officers who were to conduct the election at polling unit levels. As a result election never took place at all Bayelsa State. Nevertheless, results were allocated at the Local government levels and transmitted to the Resident Electoral Commissioner in Yenagoa who in turn announced victory for the 3rd Respondent in the presidential election. As a result the 3rd Petitioner's party agents at ward and poling unit levels found themselves lonely and idle at their duty posts as the 4th Respondent officers were nowhere to be found .

This was the experience in Kolokumo/Opolkumo, Ogbia, Southern Ijaw, Brass and Yenagoa Local Governemnt Areas and the other others.

In the few cases where election materials, but without result forms , arrived, they were were so small they had to be rationed at the rate of 50 pieces of ballot papers per polling units, notwithstanding that a polling unit has, on the average, about 500 registered voters.

BENUE STATE

- iv. In Benue State, the election materials were brought in late in most parts of the state, except Makurdi, the state capital. In few places in various local government areas where election took place at all, election materials were not distributed earlier than 3.00pm. Indeed, in Gwer Local Government Area election did not hold at all but results were announced by the electoral officer after the election had been diverted to the house of the Local Government Caretaker Chairman who is a PDP stalwart.

There were ballot stuffing, violence and intimidation of the voters and the ballot papers were not serially numbered. Election materials were handed over to PDP stalwarts to manipulate as suited their fancy. Retired military officers, who belonged to 3rd Respondent, used their connection in the army hierarchy to influence the security personnel deployed on the day of election to collude with 3rd Respondent in perpetrating rigging, intimidating and maiming opponents. A vivid example was that of one Chief Godwin Daboh Azuana, a PDP chieftain who patrolled the Vandekya Local Government Area in a 12-seater bus protected by armed mobile policemen to snatch electoral material meant for the conduct of the election. Similarly in Buruku Local Government , a local government caretaker chairman, honourable Azor Chimegh diverted 23 ballot boxes out of 2y6 provided for Mbapen Ward to the Local Government Secretariat, where they were thumb printed and votes arbitrarily allocated to PDP as winner.

Form EC8As and EC8Bs were produced in two parallel copies in duplicates bearing the same serial numbers to generate parallel results one of which invariably is authenticated and relied upon simply because majority votes were allocated to the 3rd Respondent therein. As a result most agents opposition parties, to the PDP controlled government in Benue State did not have copies of election results to audit and confirm their authenticity at various level of collation.

Typical examples of these duplicitous result forms are those from Benue South Senatorial District in Benue State; which were discovered to have been replicated in other states of the federation following identical pattern.

CROSS RIVER STATE

- v. In Cross River State, the Presidential Election did not take place on Saturday, 21st April, 2007; in Cross River North Senatorial District, in fact, election was conducted on Sunday the 22nd of April, 2007 because election materials were not flown in with military aircraft until about 6.15pm on Saturday evening and this affected the following local governments: Ogoja, Yala, Boki, Bekwara, Obanliku, and Obudu that bestride two senatorial districts. During the conduct of the said election on Sunday, 22nd April, 2007, the agents and officers of the 3rd Respondent were given materials as presiding officers and supervisors. The Presidential Election were carried out by the 3rd Respondent's personnel and resulted in most voters being disenfranchised. No notice of the arbitrary change of the date of election was officially announced , and most voters never got know of much less see the election allegedly held on the following day; instead voters went to attend their Sunday church services, which situation was exploited by the agents of 3rd and 4th Respondent to concoct spurious election results at Local Government levels in which majority of votes were allocated to the 1st Respondent.

In Cross River South Senatorial District that comprises of Calabar South, Municipal, Odukpani, Akamkpa, Bakassi and Akpaberio Local Government Areas election took place on the 21st day of April, 2007; election materials were handed over to PDP officials who conducted election in their residences. There was no voting at the designated polling units in nearly all the Areas. However, in some polling units, few ballot papers were taken there without result sheets.

Also, in Cross River Central, on the 21st day of April, 2007, election materials were distributed without result sheet to Abi, Biase, Obubura, Ikom and Etung Local Government Areas. The thumb printing was done by the PDP officials under the protection of the police and military men in some areas like Ikom Four Corner and Edor.

EBONYI STATE

- vi. In Ebonyi State, election materials without election result forms were all that were distributed to the various local government areas outside of Abakaliki mostly very late in the evening such that they never got to their destinations in good times to be used for the election. Irregularities masterminded by officials of the 4th Respondent, intimidation with active support of security agents characterized the election where it held at all particularly in Afikpo South, Ebonyi South, Ohaozara, Ivo, Afikpo North, ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot boxes were snatched; election materials meant for voting were abandoned in the bush, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences.

EDO STATE

- vii. In Edo State particularly in Akoko Edo Local Government Area in Edo North Senatorial District, and Edo Central Senatorial District comprising Esan Central, Esan North-East, Esan South-East, Esan West, Esako Central, and Igueben, ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot

boxes were snatched, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences.

EKITI STATE

- viii. Voting materials were snatched by hoodlums accompanied by the police in all the 11 wards of Ido-Osi Local Government Area. Unauthorized private vehicle with Registration Number LD 365 LFD and AK 345 DK were used to convey election materials instead of the approved vehicles of the 4th Respondent. Also in Ido-Ekiti, hoodlums snatched ballot boxes and this was reported to the police.

ENUGU STATE

- ix. In Enugu State, particularly in Ezeagu Local Government Area, election did not take place in 19 out of the 20 wards. There were late arrivals of election materials and no supply of election materials. In Akpugoeze in particular, the 4th Respondent's officials were not present and there were no election in some parts of the state.

In Oji River, there was no election because of late arrival of electoral material and there were no result sheets save for Inyi Wards I and II where voting started at about 5.00pm.

In Enugu North Local Government Area, election materials arrived without result sheets same for Udenu Local Government Area.

In Nsukka Local Government Area, the 4th Respondent's agents came and started accreditation for few minutes and later packed up the materials with the aid of the police fully armed, left the place to unknown area, at about 7.00pm.

GOMBE STATE

- x. In Gombe State particularly in Gombe South Senatorial District, ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot boxes were snatched; election materials meant for voting were abandoned in the bush, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences. In the few places where voting took place at all, election materials did not arrive local government areas until about 3pm, making it impossible for several eligible voters who had waited all day to vote; majority had to leave in the belief that the election material were not forthcoming because nobody was on hand to explain the reason for the delay in the arrival of election materials to them. Despite these delays, even where election materials eventually arrived, irregularities and malpractices reported to law enforcement agents against 3rd and 4th respondent officials went unchecked. Evidence abounded of the foregoing incidents and non-compliance with the Electoral Act and guideline in most local government areas including Kaltungo, Gombe, Akko, Tombe and Local Government Areas as well as Kwami, Funakaye, Nafida and Dukku Local Government Areas.

IMO STATE

- xi. In Imo State, particularly in Owerri North and South Local Government Areas, there were no election materials. Where election materials arrived at all, it did as late as 5.30pm, and in some cases 7pm. The election materials meant for the Local Government Areas were diverted to the Government House, Owerri where thumb printing took place.
- In Njiaba Local Government, there were no election materials at the polling units, particularly in Okigwe and Orlu senatorial zones. Voters were intimidated by the presence of heavily-armed mobile policemen and military men on patrol. The few ballot papers brought to the

Local Government Areas were distributed to agents and loyalists of the 3rd Respondent.

- Further, there were no election materials and no election took place as at 3.30pm in the following local government areas: EHEME-MBANO, ISIALAMBANO, ONUIMO, NJABA, OBOWU, IHITE UBOMA, and OWERRI MUNICIPAL.
- The ward Chairman and supervisor of the 3rd Petitioner was disallowed from voting in his polling unit at Achiga polling booth in Ugbule Ward of Njeaba Local Government Area.
- Supporters of the 3rd Respondent along with political hoodlums attacked the said Chairman, beating him mercilessly and had to be rushed to the Christian Community Clinic at Umuaka town, but had to be transferred to the Federal Medical Centre in Owerri as a result of the seriousness of the injury.
- There were unlawful thumb printings by agents of the 3rd Respondent.
- In EHEME-MBANO Local Government Area, election materials were not brought until after the time prescribed by the 4th Respondent thereby resulting in no election in that Local Government Area. Voters who had earlier come went home disappointed.
- In Nkwere Local Government Area, election materials were brought late in a private vehicle armed with thugs and military personnel.
- Also in Ibele Ward of Njeaba Local Government Area, there was no election as at 6.00pm because the 3rd Respondent's officials along with the policemen in particular PC No.: 413347 diverted the election materials.

JIGAWA STATE

- xii. In Jigawa State, the election materials were brought in late and this infuriated the youths who set the state office of the 4th Respondent on fire. There were ballot stuffing, violence and intimidation of the voters and the ballot papers were not serially numbered.

KATSINA STATE

- xiii. In Katsina State, election was characterized by short supply, or non-delivery and high-jacking of election materials. There was lack of result Forms EC8As and EC8Bs. Armed thugs recruited from outside the state were unleashed on the electorates and non PDP party agents in various local government areas. These thugs were supported by police and army personnel to harass non PDP supporters and party agents. They colluded with INEC officials and PDP stalwarts to snatch ballot boxes and ballot papers which were taken away to unknown destinations only to be returned under police protection filled with thumb-printed ballot papers. Incidents of these malpractices were rampant in Batagarawa, Mani, Daura and majority of other Local Government Areas including Katsina, the state capital.

Voter vigilance led to spontaneous resistance of this intimidation and malpractices by the electorates leading to fatalities. There were several outbreak of violence and maiming throughout the state which effectively disrupted elections in many polling units as the atmosphere was unsafe for voting or counting of votes in many local government Areas. Nevertheless, the 4th Respondent returned mind-boggling results in favour of the 1st Respondent in the State.

Some of the incidents were reported to the State and National Officers of 4th Respondent, and the Nigeria police but no action was taken to bring them to justice. In cases where PDP suspects were arrested by the police, they were released in no time before the end of the voting

thereby creating a feeling of helplessness in the citizenry that the PDP was above the law.

KEBBI STATE

- xiv. In Kebbi State, the Governor of Kebbi State, Adamu Aliero, a member of the 3rd Respondent brought ballot boxes stuffed with ballot papers into Yawuri and repeated same at Argungu Local Government Area in company of stern and battle ready armed soldiers and police driving in convoy. Election materials were brought late into the state. As a result of late arrival of election materials, in the few places where voting took place at all, election materials did not arrive local government areas until about 3pm, making it impossible for several eligible voters who had waited all day to vote; majority had to leave in the belief that the election materials were not forthcoming because nobody was on hand to explain the reason for the absence of election materials to them. Despite these delays, even where election materials eventually arrived, irregularities and malpractices were perpetrated by agents of 3rd and 4th Respondents in collusion with law enforcement agents. The prevalence of the foregoing incidents and non-compliance with the Electoral Act and guideline were most glaring in Besse, Jega, Zuru, Yauri, Danko-Wasagu and Local Government Areas.

KWARA STATE

- xv. In Kwara State, election materials were brought in late. No election took place in Kwara South Senatorial District except in Irepodun Local Government Area. In Central Senatorial zone of the state, announcement of postponement of senatorial election misled the teeming voters into believing that the Presidential Election was equally postponed.

In Kwara North, it was reported on the NTA Television that election started at 10.00am in Iyaru village and by 10.30am, voting had closed. The ballot boxes were filled

with thumb-printed ballot sheets. Five (5) ad hoc staff employed by the 3rd Respondents and their agents were arrested and made confessional statements on the television.

In Ifelodun Local Government, election results were prepared by PDP in which one Samuel Jimoh witnessed all Form EC8Bs, as the 3rd Respondent's agents in all the wards of the Local Government, although no election took place.

The Form EC8Bs in the said Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State shall be founded upon as typical evidence of unlawful voting in private residences of the 3rd Respondent's supporters in several states of the federation. Similar incidents shall be relied upon particularly as may be procured from inspection and copying of election result forms in the custody of the 4th Respondent pursuant to the Order of this Court made on Monday, 14th April, 2007 at the instance of the Petitioners.

KOGI STATE

- xvi. In Kogi State, particularly in Okene, Okehi, Ajaokuta, Dekina and Ankpa Local Government Areas, election materials arrived late. There were no voting in most of the polling units in all the Local Government Areas, election materials were diverted by unknown persons in all the Local Government Areas and soldiers and police men were shooting and carted away election materials from the Local Government Areas.

In Yagba East, Kabba/Gunu, Ajaokuta, Ida, Igala, Mela/Odoki, Olamaboro and Ofu Local Government Areas, no election took place in most of the wards because of late arrival of election materials, including result forms, acts of thuggery by PDP supporters who high jacked ballot boxes and took them to private and unknown destinations to thumb-print. The boxes in many cases were returned

filled with thumb-printed ballot papers in company of armed policemen.

NASSARAWA STATE

xvii. There was no voting in Nassarawa West Senatorial District. In the other senatorial districts of the state, Election materials were brought late into the state. there was pervasive late arrival of election materials, In the few places where voting took place at all, election materials did not arrive local government areas until about 3pm, making it impossible for several eligible voters who had waited all day, to vote; majority had to leave in the belief that the election material were not forthcoming because nobody was on hand to explain the reason for the absence of election materials to them. Despite these delays, even where election material s eventually arrived , irregularities and malpractices were perpetrated by agents of 3rd and 4th respondents in collusion which law enforcement agents who beat up or intimidated identified opposition party agents , and some traditional rulers who offered their palaces as sanctuary for rigging. The prevalence of the foregoing incidents and non-compliance with the Electoral Act and guideline were most glaring in Awe, Keana, Lafia, Doma, Nasarawa, Kokona and Obi Local government Areas where results presented at the Local Government collation centres and wards levels showed manipulation of figures. Results Forms were duplicated with same serial numbers and used to replace genuine results from polling units and wards from. Protests by 3rd petitioners agents at the local government collation centers across the state were ignored, as well as at the State collation level.

NIGER STATE

xviii. In Niger State, at Suleja Local Government Area, when the election was completed, counting was not done at the polling unit. Ballot papers were carried to the 4th Respondent's office by the agents of the 3rd Respondent.

Counting could not be effected as irate youths threatened to burn down the 4th Respondent's secretariat but for the intervention of the Emir of Suleja.

In Minna Township, some members of the 3rd Respondent were caught with ballot boxes. This incidence was reported to the police and those agents were kept in police custody at Minna.

Further, electoral boxes were stolen from the following wards in Minna Central:

- a. Makera ward;
- b. Hassan Kukuruku;
- c. Kofan Nadak;
- d. Ansarudin Mosque; and
- e. Hospital Gate.

Evidence shall be led to establish the aforementioned allegations through video clips, photographs, international and local observers' report, newspapers and magazines including *The News Magazine, Tell, The Guardian, ThisDay, Nigerian Tribune and The Nation.*

OGUN STATE

- xix. Election in Abeokuta North, Abeokuta South, Owode Obafemi, Odeda, Ewekoro, Ifo, Ijebu East, Ijebu North East, Ijebu Ode , Remo North ,Yewa South , Yewa North Local Government Areas, were characterized by mind boggling irregularities. Ballot papers were stuffed in ballot boxes, ballot boxes snatched, with several agents of the 1st - 4th Respondents arrested in connection with these offences. There was late delivery of election materials and undersupply of ballot papers so that eligible voters were disenfranchised for lack of ballot papers. Even where voting took place, the ballot boxes were snatched before close of polls and counting of ballots by PDP supporters aided by soldiers and armed policemen who were to provide security during the election. Some

PDP supporters were seen carrying arms, alongside armed security personnel. Agents of 3rd Petitioners were prevented from observing the conduct of the elections, beaten up where they insisted on their right. Most of these incidents of electoral malpractices were captured on video and phone recordings and photographs which shall be founded upon.

OSUN STATE

- xx. Voters were intimidated by security officials particularly in Ife Local Government Area, also in Inisa, Odo-Otin Local Government Areas; agents of the 3rd Petitioner were driven away from the polling units by security agents.

In majority of the Local Government Areas, the delivery of election materials was abysmally late and did not reach a substantial number of wards until the official time for the close of election. The earliest sighting of election materials at polling units were recorded at about 11pm. Even then ballot boxes and papers were hijacked by soldiers and PDP party faithfuls. Elections were not declared at the polling units hence opposition party agents including the 3rd Petitioner never sighted the election result forms in the various polling units and wards assigned to them for election monitoring. There was brazen intimidation and killing of non PDP voters and party agents particularly in Ilesha Area. Video recordings of some of these incidents shall be founded upon at the trial.

OYO STATE

- xxi. Voters were intimidated by security officials particularly in Ogbomoso Local Government Area, also; agents of the 3rd Petitioner were driven away from the polling units by security agents.

In majority of the Local Government Areas, the delivery of election materials was abysmally late and did not reach

a substantial number of wards until the official time for the close of election. The earliest sighting of election materials at polling units were recorded at about 11pm. Even then ballot boxes and papers were hijacked by soldiers and PDP party faithfuls. Elections were not declared at the polling units hence opposition party agents including the 3rd Petitioner never sighted the election result forms in the various polling units and wards assigned to them for election monitoring. There was brazen intimidation and maiming of identified non PDP voters and party agents leading to fatalities. Video recordings of some of these incidents shall be founded upon at the trial.

RIVERS STATE

- xxii. There was non delivery of election materials, in most of the local government of areas except the state capital port Harcourt. In Port Harcourt the delivery of election materials was abysmally late and did not reach a substantial number of wards until the official time for the close of election. The earliest sighting of election materials at polling units were recorded at about 1pm. Even then ballot papers were undersupplied thereby disenfranchising majority of eligible voters.

Even where voting took place, the ballot boxes were snatched before close of polls and counting of ballots by PDP supporters aided by soldiers and armed policemen who were to provide security during the election. Some PDP supporters were seen carrying arms, alongside armed security personnel. Agents of 3rd Petitioners were prevented from observing the conduct of the elections; they were beaten up where they insisted on their right. Incidents of this nature typified the conduct of the election in Tai, Oyigbo, Port Harcourt, Akuku -Toru, Okrika, Bonny, Degema, Gokana, Asari-Toru, Angulama and Eleme Local Government Areas in the State.

The election material supplied at wards and local government levels did not include result forms EC8As and EC8Bs on which scores were to be recorded and transmitted to Local Government and State capital for further collation. As a result the opposition party agents at the state collation centre objected to the collation done by the State Resident Electoral commissioner. They thus refused to sign the final result for state collation at the presidential election, on the basis that the results were product of vote allocation and not collation.

Most of these incidents of electoral malpractices were captured on video and phone recordings and photographs which shall be founded upon.

ZAMFARA STATE

- xxi. In Zamfara State, election materials were brought in late and as a result, no election was held up to the time fixed for election was over in virtually all the local government areas with the exception of the state capital. As a result, majority of eligible voters were disenfranchised; and opposition party agents, particularly those of 3rd Petitioners, were deprived the opportunity to observe the conduct of the election. Nevertheless, the 4th Respondent upheld the election results from all the local government areas in the state in which a majority of the votes allegedly cast were allocated to the 3rd Respondent, whose loyalists constituted the bulk of the ad-hoc staff recruited to conduct the elections.
19. In all the acts of malpractices and irregularities set out in the preceding paragraphs herein, the 811th - 1576th Respondents are just a few of INEC officials below the level of the Electoral Officers who directly aided, participated in assisting the 4th - 808th Respondents in a carefully plotted scheme to foist the 1st Respondent on the Nigerian electorate in disregard of the sanctity of their franchise as guaranteed by the Electoral Act, 2006. The Presiding Officers and Poll Clerks at polling unit level were practically powerless to exercise their mandate given the collusion of law enforcement agencies in the misconduct of the election and compromising

integrity and security of election materials where they were distributed at all at the local government and ward levels.

Evidence and Reports of Independent Election Observers and the media that covered the election with unrestricted access throughout the 36 states of Nigeria and the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja are consistent with the facts of corrupt practices pleaded above in even greater details, and shall be founded upon at the trial.

20. Before and during the election, the 5th Respondent exhibited acts of gross bias with impunity against the person and candidature of the 1st Petitioner including:
 - a. publicly calling the 1st Petitioner a ‘frustrated politician’;
 - b. falsely describing the 3rd Petitioner as an illegal organization not having being registered by INEC;
 - c. after the Judgment in Suit No.: FHC/ABJ/CS/03/07 pleaded in 16 (iv) above, the 5th Respondent boasted that he will not comply with the Judgment unless compelled by the Supreme Court;
 - d. in the course of processing the 1st Petitioner’s nomination, the 5th Respondent falsely denied receipt of the 1st Petitioner’s photograph required to be placed on the ballot paper when in actual fact same had been duly delivered.
21. In addition to the specific instances of election malpractices stated above, the 4th Respondent abruptly announced postponement of the National Assembly election in several constituencies spanning 29 states of the federation on the day of the election, thereby misleading eligible voters into believing that the Presidential Election was equally postponed.
22. Your Petitioners state that the 1st Respondent did not score majority of lawful vote cast at the 21st April, 2007 Presidential Election by reasons of the facts pleaded in the preceding paragraphs of this Petition which are herein repeated. Evidence shall be led by the Petitioners to show that the results credited to the 1st and 2nd

Respondents were collated from unlawful votes recorded from the polling units to the collation centers.

23. Your Petitioners aver that while election results from 25 states of the federation were still being awaited the 5th Respondent excused himself and went out of the collation center at the Headquarters of the 4th Respondent leaving behind the party agents and announced the result of the Presidential Elections, declaring the 1st Respondent the winner and making pronouncements of victory for the 1st - 3rd Respondents as the Returning Officer.
24. Your Petitioners state that results from 11 states then available were not enough to support the return of the 1st Respondent as the winner of the election.

Your Petitioners will rely on the CD and video clips of the announcement made by the 5th Respondent and the detailed results of the Presidential Election, state by state and local government by local government at the trial of this Petition as may be obtained in the course of Court ordered inspection made on Monday, 14th April, 2007; written, visual and audio reports of international and local observers especially NDI, IRI, EU, JDPC, and TMG.

Notice is hereby given to each and all the Respondents herein to produce originals and/or admissible Certified True Copies of each and/or all of the documents referred to in this Petition which in the ordinary course of official business are either with them, in their custody or under their control for the purpose of the trial in this Petition.

WHEREOF YOUR PETITIONERS PRAY THAT:

1. It may be determined that the Presidential Election of 21st April, 2007 is invalid for unlawful exclusion of the 1st and 2nd Petitioners who were validly nominated by the 3rd Petitioner as its candidate at the Presidential election, and that the said election be nullified.

ALTERNATIVELY THAT:

2. It may be determined that Alhaji Umaru Musa Yar'Adua who was returned by the 4th - 6th Respondents as the President-elect based on the Presidential Election held on 21st April 2007 was not duly elected (or returned) and his election be nullified.
3. It may be determined that the said Presidential election held on 21st April 2007 is invalid for non compliance with the provisions of Electoral Act 2006, which non-compliance had substantially affected the result of the election, and that the election be nullified.
4. It may be determined that the said Election be invalidated or annulled by reason of widespread corrupt practices, and that the election be nullified.
5. It may be determined that a fresh election be conducted into the office of the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, in accordance with Section 147 of the Electoral Act, 2006 at which the 1st and 2nd Petitioners shall be accorded full and unimpeded right to contest as validly nominated candidates.
6. It may be determined that the 5th, 7th - 42nd Respondents as officials of the 4th Respondent, who directly and negligently mis-conducted the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election in contravention of the provision of the Electoral Act, 2006 be recommended for criminal prosecution by the Attorney General pursuant to Section 157 of the Electoral Act, 2006.
7. It may be recommended that the 5th, 7th - 42nd Respondents who supervised and/or mis-conducted the April 21, 2007 Presidential Election be prohibited from participating in the conduct of the fresh election which may be ordered in consequence of this Petition.
8. And for such order or further orders as the Honourable Court may deem fit to make in the circumstance.
